Participants MUST BE confirmed no later than Friday, January 20th

We have an exciting and unique opportunity for member participation. This venue may attract 1500+ jazz (and art) enthusiasts over 3 days in February. Your response about participation is needed immediately for this unique opportunity.

Once we know the number of participants willing to commit their time and energy we can design our displays based on space availability and possibly individual preferences (table vs. easel etc), using panels or grids that are available, etc...but first we need to know number of participants

What: Seaside Jazz Festival

Where: Seaside Convention Center

When: February 24-26, 2012; Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Friday 8:00am thru 11:15pm (Set up 8:00am)

Saturday 9:00am thru 11:45pm

Sunday 8:00am thru 3:00pm (Take down 3:00pm)

Costs: \$5-\$15 depending on number of participants; this cost is solely for table cloths and skirts for tables

15% Commission is taken at end of weekend for any and all sales (art, cards, prints, boxes, etc) to be paid to the Convention Center

15% Commission to be paid to TEAA

Logistics, Responsibilities, Info:

**This event is NOT insured, participants will sign waivers. Center does have security but does not take any liability.

** Each artist participant will be responsible for set up, management and take

down of their own display. Assistance will be provided where needed by fellow artists.

**Spaces will be designated once all participants have committed to the event;

* 8 foot tables will be furnished, - - - skirting and table cloths will cost \$15

* Table Easels would be beneficial if artists have them

* Artists who have lightweight panels or grids could feasibly use them in lieu of table space, TBD

* Easels - spaces do not allow for too many, so artists may opt for tables OR easels, etc.

* Space will allow for 3-4 Print Racks, total number TBD

* Card Racks could be transferred from TEAA to be displayed near lobby area adjacent to money "station". Artists are encouraged to display their cards with their art also.

****Number of Art pieces will depend on number of Artists participating; Could be 3-6, or more depending on the "spaces divided by artists"...panels vs tables, etc.**

**TEAA will be responsible for accounting of all monies at one station near the lobby; a phone jack will be provided for our credit card machine (we think). The standard "log book and receipts" will be completed for all transactions similar to gallery procedures.

**Hours of Operation are "LONG" !! Each artist can enlist "buddies" to help watch their art display, but everyone must sign up to work the event. The event will minimally require at least 6-8 artists.

Budget 2012:

Although the budget for 2012 has not been finalized, the Treasurer distributed the statistics for 2011 and asked for requests for next year's budget. Steve Parsons made a brief presentation about his findings concerning insulation in the attic. He stated that he received a bid of \$1000 to have insulation put into the attic and after checking into costs, found that bid to be realistic. Motion was made and passed that Steve have the insulation installed for a cost of \$1000. A list of other maintenance items to investigate included a vapor barrier under the floor, windows on West side of building (for dryrot).. Also with new requests, Jeanette looked into cost of new bookcases for the classroom since the low ones we have are not big enough for the number of books we have. She requested \$150 to buy 3 upright book storage units to put in the classroom and office area. Motion made and approved.

New business:

Jazz festival is February 24-26. Susan Thomas gave a presentation about the festival and how we can be involved in showing and selling our artwork. Each member would be responsible for setting up and working his/her own space either alone or with a group of other TE members. Sales would be handled at one particular table where we can keep a cashbox and credit card swiper. Festival is open until midnight, but member could close kiosk down anytime. Card racks from TE could be used by check out table to sell members' cards. The festival operators have tables for us and chairs to use.. Set up would be Friday 8 AM.

Susan needs to know by January 20 which individual members are interested in doing this. Meeting was adjourned at 1:54 PM
