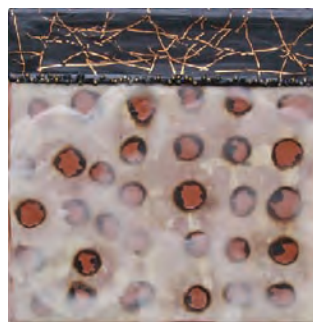

Susan Romersa Featured

Susan Romersa was born in New York and lived with her family in the beautiful Catskill mountains, moving to Las Vegas at age 16 with her mother and grandmother. Her mother was an accomplished artist.

She graduated from Las Vegas HS and moved to Southern California, graduating from Business College, then taking classes in psychology, philosophy, art, and creative writing at U.C.L.A. While working for Electronic Design Magazine, she enrolled in John Robert Powers Modeling School.

Moving back to Las Vegas in her early 20's, she married and she and her husband, Jim, had two daughters – Lauren and Kristen.

Susan worked part time and also took some art classes during her seven year marriage, but they divorced, and with two young daughters, she began work full time.

Las Vegas hotels seemed the most likely place to offer steady employment.

Susan started her hotel career at the Sahara Hotel in Convention Sales, and within two years, moved to the Publicity Department. She moved to the Sands Hotel and worked in Convention Sales as an Administrative Assistant – moving on to the Sands Publicity Department – when an opening appeared. She also met her second husband, Tony, at the Sands.

She says that the Sands was a remarkable place to work – and considered herself fortunate to have a mentor in the Advertising and Public Relations field – Al Freeman – the Director of the Department – well-known for all publicity and media events since the hotel opened. His efforts garnered worldwide attention for the resort.

Freeman encouraged her writing endeavors and she gained valuable experience over the years - eventually becoming responsible for all showroom,



lounge, and general publicity for the hotel and its public relations efforts. She says the Sands was like one big family and she had an amazing 14 years there. The hotel was good to its employees – and held a lavish annual Christmas party for the employees' children.

The Sands eventually was sold – and today is the Venetian Hotel – owned by Sheldon Adelson. The Sands was imploded in 1996, making way for the new Megaresort.

From there, she went to work at Caesars Palace as Public Relations Manager – a fast-paced and exciting environment.

After several years, Susan started her own PR and Marketing business. She worked from home – and having become a grandmother – she enjoyed a lighter schedule that allowed time for activities with her grandkids.

Her daughter, Kristen, moved to Oregon with her family – and Susan would occasionally visit and loved the area.

In 2005, the real estate market in Las Vegas was booming – and Susan was ready to move to a cooler green place. She sold her home and moved to Seaside.

Susan has been a member of Trails End for five years – and says she marvels at the work of so many talented artists on display each month.

Size limitations, Number of Entries, and Fees:

Artists may submit TWO pieces NOT to exceed 24" x 30" (720 sq. in.) If a piece exceeds 24" x 30", then ONE piece will be accepted. \$15 entry fee for NON-TEAA members. NO fee for TEAA members.

Appearance:

Two-dimensional artwork must be professionally mounted, framed, or presented appropriately. NO glass edges or sawtooth hangers allowed. All wires should be at least 1" below the top of the frame.
