

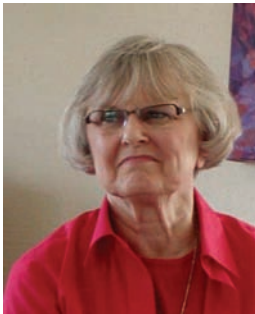

Jo Pomeroy-Crockett Featured Artist

Art was all important in Jo Pomeroy-Crockett's life. Her grandfather was an artist from Vienna. He walked from Nova Scotia to Chicago to attend the Chicago Art Institute. From the time Jo could hold a pencil, she drew with him.

Jo creates in watercolor, pastel, mixed media, and collage. In addition to her work as a freelance writer and educator, her painting offers opportunities to experiment with various techniques, approaches, and materials.

Pomeroy-Crockett, a native of Arizona and a happy transplant in Oregon, holds a Ph.D. She completed advanced work at Oxford University, Oxford, England and the University of Jordan, Ammon, Jordan. She taught undergraduate and graduate classes for Phoenix College, Northern Arizona University, and the University of Phoenix. She currently

teaches watercolor and collage on the Oregon coast, writes children's books and articles for regional publications.

Pomeroy-Crockett's work has appeared in numerous juried exhibits and one-woman shows. Her work is in private collections in the U.S. and abroad.

Working primarily wet-into-wet, the artist strives for dramatic value patterns. Bright colors, emphasis on the play of light, and a touch of whimsy mark her paintings.

She has been a member of Trail's End for 8 years and is a past President.

Board Minutes November 12, 2010

Call to Order

President Mary Ann Gantenbein called the meeting to order at approximately 9:35 a.m. Members present: President Mary Ann Gantenbein, Second Vice President Jeannette Davis, Treasurer Beverly Peck, Member-at-large Susan Bish and future co member-at-large Jane Means. Not present: First President Patty Davis. Jo Pomeroy-Crockett and Kitty Paino came later in the meeting to make presentations to the Board.

Secretaries Report

Last months minutes were filed by Patty Davis filling in for Lou Kister. There were no corrections to the minutes.

Treasurers Report

Treasurer Beverly Peck reported as of November 1, 2010 our bank balance is \$1,788.48. Our income for October was \$626.00 and our expenses were \$783.29 leaving our bank balance of \$1,788.48. The financial statement was approved by Susan Bish and seconded by Jeannette. Beverly stated she has created a new report tracking artist sales. The report lists sales paid by check to TEAA by artist with commission deducted and check number listed by each artist. The cash sales were also listed as a lump sum. The Board requested Bev also break down the cash sales by artist and commissions. Beverly agreed to the addition to the report. Beverly needed clarification from some receipts. The Board discussed how we can improve receipts and training of Gallery sitters. Beverly requested a vote to renew our advertising in the Daily Astorian Visitors Guide for 2011 costing \$295.00. The Board voted to approve this expense.

Membership

Jeannette Davis reported we now have 109 members. We added to new members in October.

Old Business

Mary Ann reported the work on our exterior lighting has been completed. The light pole has been fixed and new hard wired motion sensor lights installed on the parking side of the building.

Kitty Paino presented a Proposal for Membership Dues Increase as a result from the Strategic Planning Meeting in September. The Proposal lists: Individual Membership - Full Year \$70 or \$65 if paid before Dec. 31st, Individual Youth (Under 18) Full Year \$35, Half year \$18, Family Membership (Residing in the same household) Full year \$80, \$75 if paid before Dec. 31st, Half year \$40,
