## December General Meeting

### Luncheon

President Jo invited all of us to start with luncheon after she had asked us to write out our suggestions for 2009 show themes and put them in the red jar. The business meeting would start later. The January-February show theme would be drawn from the red jar.

### Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Beverly Peck reported that our Bank of Astoria balance on November 1<sup>st</sup> was \$1,200.68. Our November income was \$151.00 and our expenses were \$572.82 leaving a balance of \$778.86. Our Capital One Money Market account including the development fund and the McWhinney fund is \$3,791.32.

### Gallery Report

Gallery Manager Albert Wood reported that we sold eight cards and packets for \$30, one photograph for \$25, three pieces of jewelry for \$95, six prints for \$98, one framed painting for \$90, one shrinkwrap painting for \$16, and two raku vases for \$195 for a total of \$485. For the December show thirty-nine artists put in eighty-four works. We thank the hanging committee: Sally Bailey, Susan Bish, Jo Pomeroy-Crockett, and Judy Frederikson for a beautifully and quickly hung show. The

January-February show theme was drawn—once again it is "Artist's Choice." Members are to pick up their work for the December show on January 1<sup>st</sup>. Gallery cleaning days are Tuesday, January 6<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, January 7<sup>th</sup>. Work for the next show is due on January 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. The show will be hung on January 14<sup>th</sup>.

### Old Business

### New Business

The theme for the show is "The Essence of the East." Seattle sumi painter Yu Ming Zsu will judge the submitted works and

choose the ones to be shown. Entry blanks will soon be available at TEAA.

Following the installation incoming President Sheila Parsons presented outgoing President Jo Pomeroy-Crockett with a commemorative plaque thanking her for her four years of dedicated work. Gallery Manager Albert Wood presented Jo with a lovely piece of his fused glass work.

### Gift Exchange

Mark Kenny conducted the gift exchange. When a member's number was called, the member chose and opened a gift. The member had the option of keeping the gift or placing it on a table and waiting for a second chance to draw again after all the wrapped gifts had been selected and opened. We all had a good time.

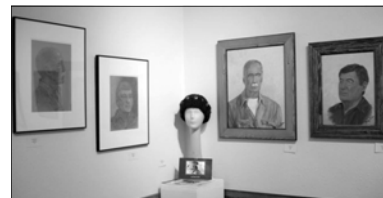
