Call to Order

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Beverly Peck stated that our Bank of Astoria account balance on June 1, 2008 was \$1,395.78. Our income for the month of June was \$89.00 and our expenses were \$1,801.45 leaving a balance of \$613.33. Our Capital One Money Market account is now \$7,258.59.

Show Manager's Report

Show Manager Albert Wood reported that in June we sold three pieces of jewelry, one framed painting, and six cards for a total of \$209.

Publicity Report

Ellen Zimet presented the publicity report. Ellen has been putting in articles for the Coast Weekend. Several of the articles have appeared in the paper. To see all of the articles, go to the Daily Astorian website. The Publicity Committee shall be putting in an ad for our August judged show.

Old Business

• Brush Sets: President Jo Pomeroy-Crockett has purchased twelve three-brush sets and watercolor compacts to be used by children and adults at Trail's End. Jo and Vice-President Sheila Parsons will package them and label them to

be used with water soluble pigments only. These will be available on a loan basis for summer art camp and summer mini workshops.

• Summer Art Camp: Janet Willener described the success of her first art camp. Jane Means contributed information about Darren Gooch's ceramic class. Jane also commented on the success of the art camp's July 4th float. Both Janet and Jane recommended teaching ages 6-9 and ages 10-12 as separate groups. Susan Bish stated that when she observed the children, all of them were totally engrossed in their art activities.

• Dots 'N Doodles Show for Trail's End Members: Intake for art works will be from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 16th and Thursday, July 17th. Works will be judged on Friday, July 18th. Members are to pick up their work on Saturday, July 19th or Monday, July 21st. Works selected by the judge are to be brought back to Dots 'N Doodles on Thursday, August 7th. The show will open on Saturday, August 9th.

New Business

• Assistance League Tour: The Assistance League provides needy children with clothing, etc. Assistance League Member Cindy Leibel presented TEAA members with an opportunity to create paintings of homes on the tour. President Jo has recommended that we do pen and ink drawings with a watercolor wash. The League will photograph the winning drawings to make cards to sell for the benefit of the League. The artist will display the original drawing at the house. If the original is sold, the artist receives the proceeds. The League needs the art by August 29th

at Trail's End. The show will be in October.

• The ad for Who's Who from The Daily Astorian: Ellen Zimet will place a quarter-page advertisement featuring TEAA in the Who's Who.

• Member News: Anne Steiner has passed away. We have sent flowers and condolences to her family. Carol Barth has been in OHSU for back surgery. Mary McDonald was in the hospital but is now home. We wish Carol and Mary full recoveries.

• DVDs Policy: The Board has set up a DVD policy. Our DVDs are not to be used outside of our Trail's End building. In August there will be a DVD showing on Mondays at 2:00 p.m.

• Cleaning the Art Center on July 31st: Sally Bailey, Susan Bish, and Lou Kister will meet at 1:00 p.m. to clean the Art Center before the August show. Other helpers would be much appreciated.

• Other: The August 8th general meeting will be at 6:00 p.m. It will be a potluck *During the August 2nd show, we will have a silent auction and a raffle with donated items such as boxed cards and jewelry. The items would have to be donations.

These "goodies" will help to bring more people into our Art Center. More visitors means more sales of artwork.

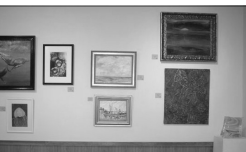
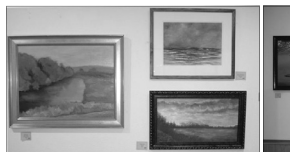
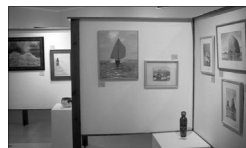
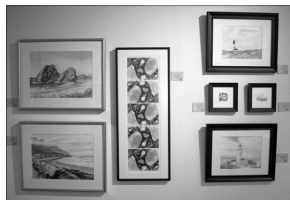
DVD Collection
