November 14 General Meeting

Call to Order

Kenny, Vice-President Sheila Parsons, Judy Frederikson, Jan Clawson, President Jo Pomeroy-Crockett, new member Margee Munte, Janet Willener, and Secretary Lou Kister.

Treasurer's Report

Our Astoria Bank balance as of October 1, 2008, was \$368.43. Our income for October was \$309.84 and expenses were \$437.59 leaving a balance of \$240.68. Treasurer Beverly transferred \$960.00 from our Capitol One Money Market account to our Bank of Astoria account giving us a balance of \$1,200.68. Our Capitol One Money Market balance is now \$3,781.49. Treasurer Beverly introduced her assistant Jeannette Davis.

Show Manager's Report

Show Manager Albert Wood said that in October we sold one calendar for \$15.00, sixteen cards for \$112, four shrink-wrapped paintings for \$245, one print for \$30, two framed paintings for \$120, and three pieces of jewelry for \$120 for a total of \$642 in sales. For our November show twenty-eight artists put in sixty-seven pieces of art. Albert thanked the Hanging Committee: Jane Means, Tom Means, Susan Bish, Lou Kister, and Albert wood for hanging a fine show. Work for the December show, "A Classy Show," is due on November 30th and December 1st between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Albert has requested that he needs clear descriptions of work that is sold in the red art sales binder. In addition to the title, he needs to know if it is an original shrink-wrapped painting, an unframed painting, a framed painting, or a print.

Old Business

*Calendar for Gallery Sitting Sign Up: In December we shall have a computer generated calendar to use for gallery sitting. If you put art work in the show, you are expected to take a turn at gallery sitting sometime from Wednesday to Sunday of that month.

New Business

*Art Center staffing--recent problems: Last month we found lights and heat were left on after closing; floors were not swept and heat guns were left plugged in after classes. We as members are responsible for the upkeep of our building.

*Election of officers: In January Sheila Parsons will become president. Bernadine Thomas will serve as Vice-President. Beverly Peck will continue to serve as treasurer. Lou Kister will serve as secretary. Albert Wood will continue as Show Manager. Susan Bish will serve as Member-at-Large.

*Holiday Meeting: Our December 12th meeting is a potluck and will start at 12:00 p.m. We will have an installation of officers, brainstorm for next year's show themes, and have a gift exchange of art related objects, new or gently used.

*Janet Bland will be teaching an acrylic class starting in the third week of January.

*Annual Cleanup: We shall be cleaning up our building on January 6th and 7th.

Afterward, necessary painting will be done.

*Newcomers Brochure: Patty Davis has designed a beautiful new brochure. President Jo Pomeroy-Crockett shared some samples with us. Thank you, Patty.

*Transition Center Project: As part of our support in helping member Patty Davis teach art to Transition Center inmates, we plan to display some of their work in our classroom in February.

President Jo requested our artists to post some of their art work at the Transition Center. Let Jo or Patty know if you are interested. It is recommended that framed work be done with Plexiglas.

*Art for the North Coast Chorale: Work members plan to submit for the theme "Light in Winter" needs to be given to President Jo by Tuesday, November 18th.

*Other: *Christy Payne has resigned her position of printing our labels for our shows because of illness in her family. We need a volunteer for this job. *We can no longer recycle at TEAA unless a member chooses to do it. We do not produce enough waste to qualify for a large recycling bin and WOW no longer empties our small yellow bin. *Please remember that a member is allowed to display only six pieces of shrink wrap work. It is a good idea to rotate your pieces. *Artist's Bios need to be updated. This will be a project for 2009.

*Jan Clawson thanked us for the "beautifully prepared newsletter."

*Vice-President Sheila Parsons thanked Marvin Burgy for putting in our smoke alarms and for putting wheels on our kitchen island.

President Jo Pomeroy-Crockett adjourned the meeting at 1:50 p.m.

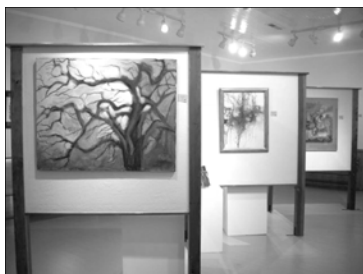
