Dots N' Doodles Juried Show

Dots N' Doodles is hosting a juried art show exclusively for the Trail's End Art Association active membership and will be held at Dots N' Doodles Art Supplies with the opening reception taking place on August 9th at 6:00 PM. This event coincides with Astoria's 2nd Saturday Art Walk on Saturday August 9th.

The theme for the artwork submitted is "**Life Under 6 inches**" and may be interpreted in any way the artist deems appropriate. The artist may want to attach a

statement to the back of their artwork of no more than a few sentences describing how they have interpreted the theme, which may assist the judge in his decision.

Artwork is due at Dots & Doodles between Wednesday July 16th through Thursday July 17th during store hours. No work will be accepted after July 17th 5:00 PM.

Originally from Shanghai, China, the show's juror Yuming began to study under the painting masters at the age of ten. He blends the styles of the East and West into his oil, pastel and Chinese watercolor paintings. Capturing the light and darkness of the European masters while strokes found in Chinese painting and calligraphy. combining the familiar and textured ink brush. Yuming finds that his art keeps him "spiritually wealthy and healthy".

The cost is \$10 to submit 3 paintings.

ENTRY RULES:

1. Up to 3 pieces may be submitted.
2. Works should be no larger than 6" x 6" or 36 sq/inches.
3. Artwork must be labeled on the back with name of artist, name of piece and price.
4. Dots & Doodles will take 20% of the amount the art work has sold for.
5. Pieces may be framed, however, frames should not be larger than an inch or so above the art work.
6. Art work may be two or three dimensional or in relief as long as it can be hung on the wall.
7. Art work must be ready to be hung on the wall (D&D is not responsible for providing wires, hooks and other hanging devices)

Current work: All artwork must have been completed within the last two years.

Originality: All artwork must be original in all respects. Artwork may not be a copy of someone's copyrighted photo, drawing, or rendering.

Number of entries per person: 2

No entry fee for members, \$15 per entry for non-members, and \$8 entry fee for children non-members.
